- b) Your general performance at work.
- c) An evaluation of your:
 - i) attitude towards learning;
 - ii) ability to work with others;
 - iii) professional integrity;
 - iv) emotional maturity;
 - v) ability to meet deadlines;
 - vi) readiness to undertake postgraduate studies outside your home country;
 - vii) leadership skills in relation to the (nature of) the supervisory role you play in your institution/organisation. (For C419 applicants only.)
